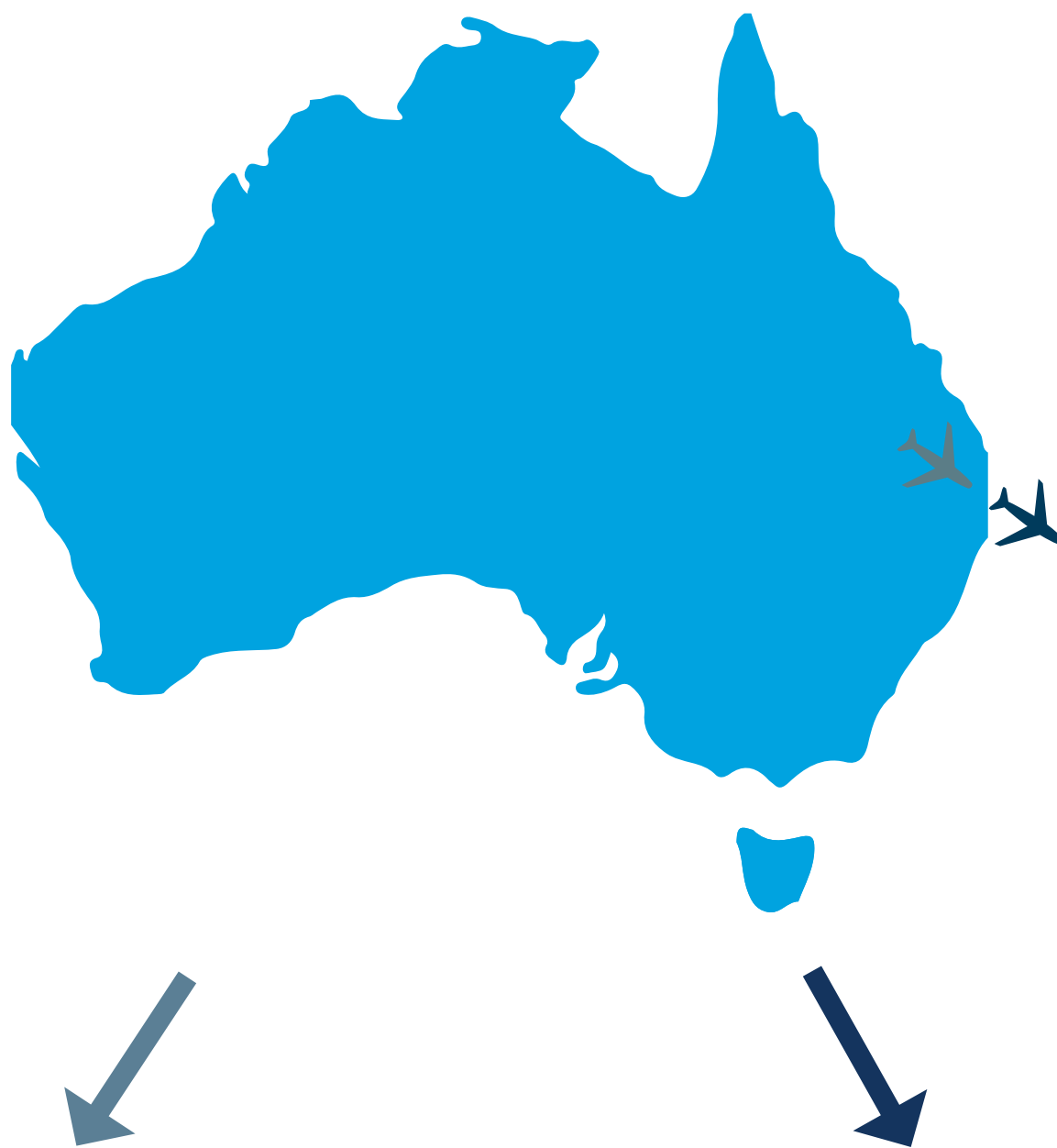


HOW MANY FLIGHTS ARRIVE AND DEPART SUNSHINE COAST AIRPORT EACH DAY?

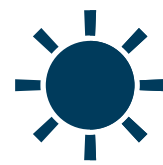

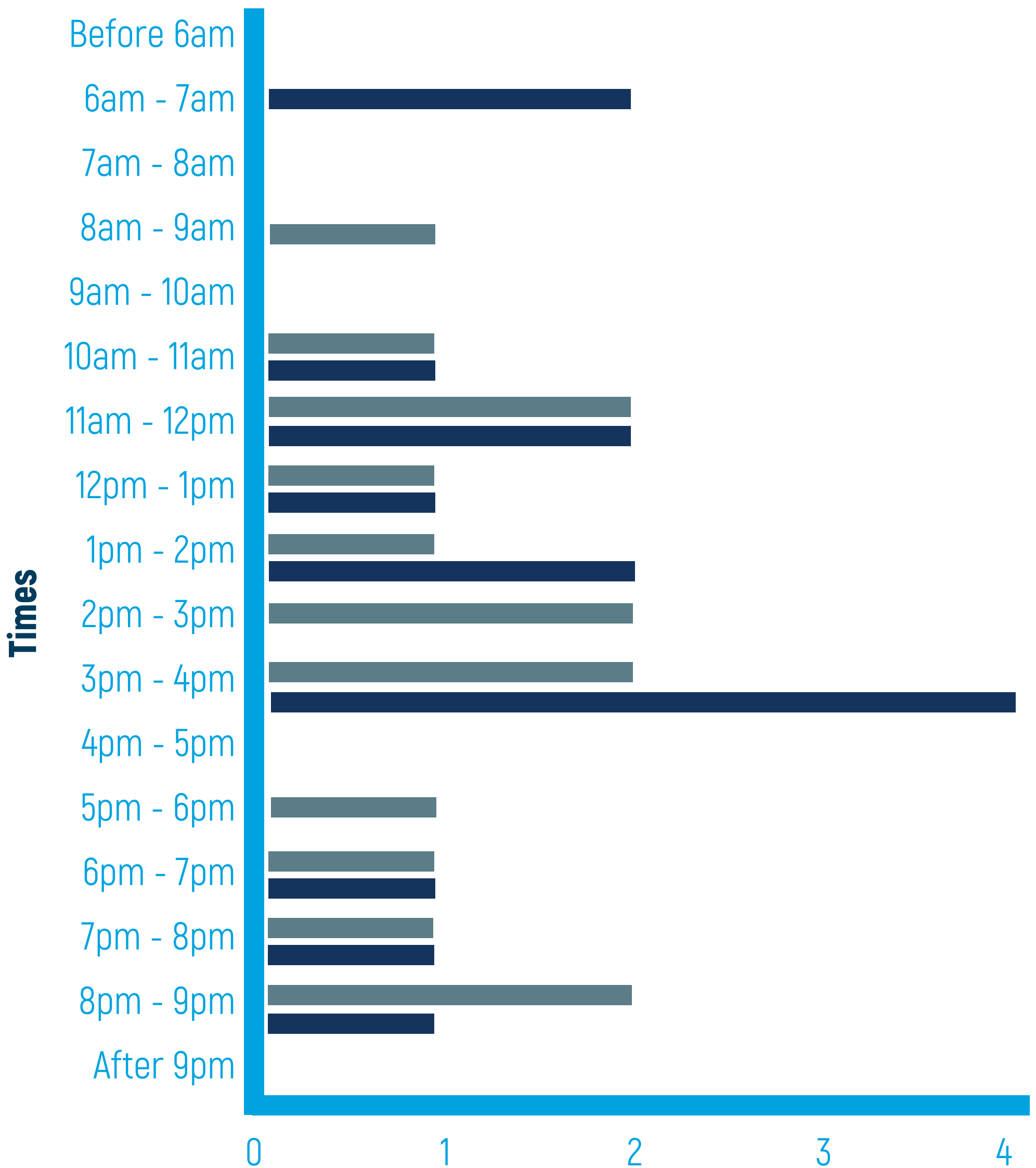

Arrivals

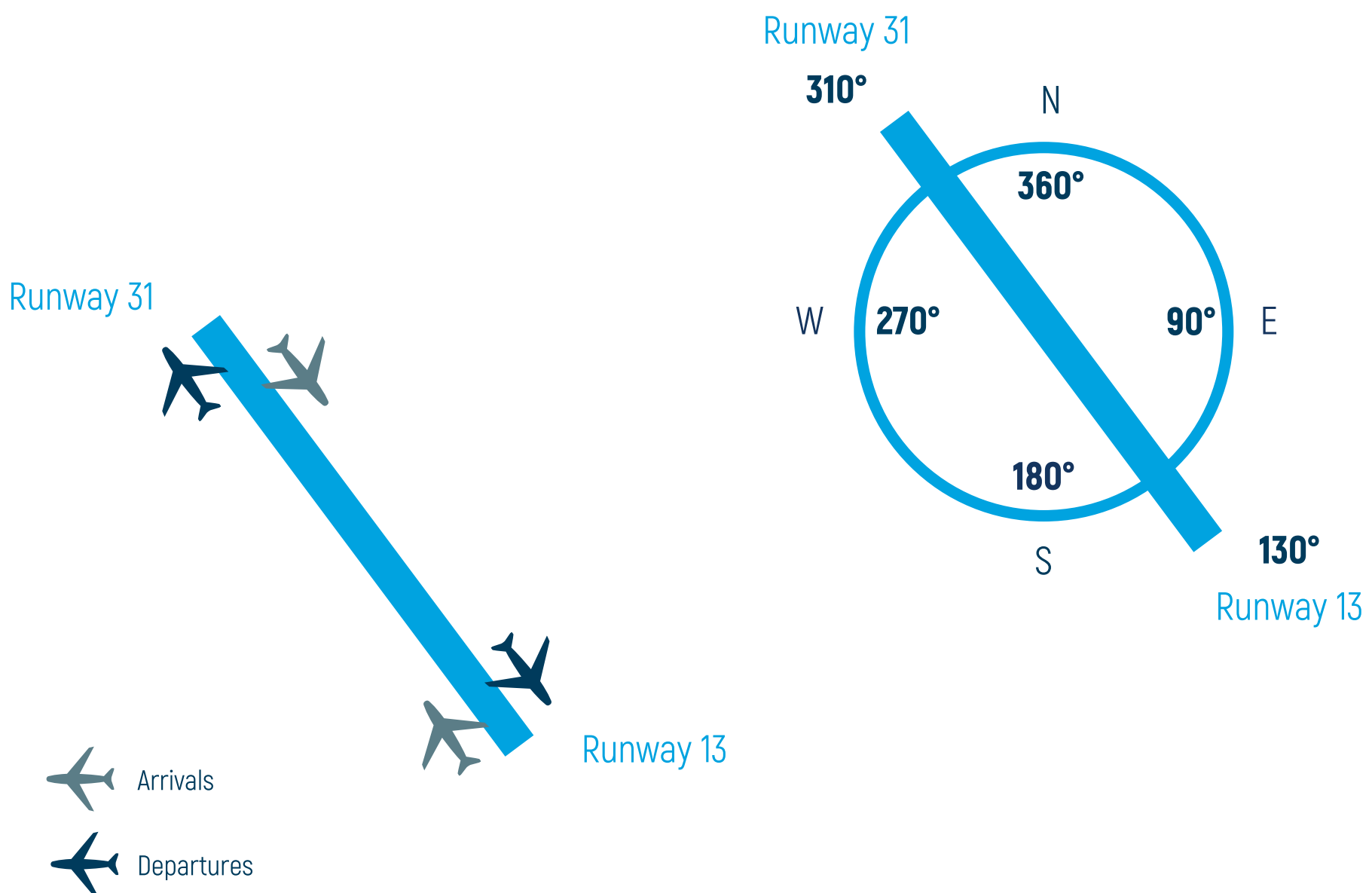


Departures

WHAT WILL THE NEW RUNWAY BE NAMED AT SUNSHINE COAST AIRPORT?

Runways can be used in two directions, and each direction is named with a two digit number based on the different directions they face on a compass.



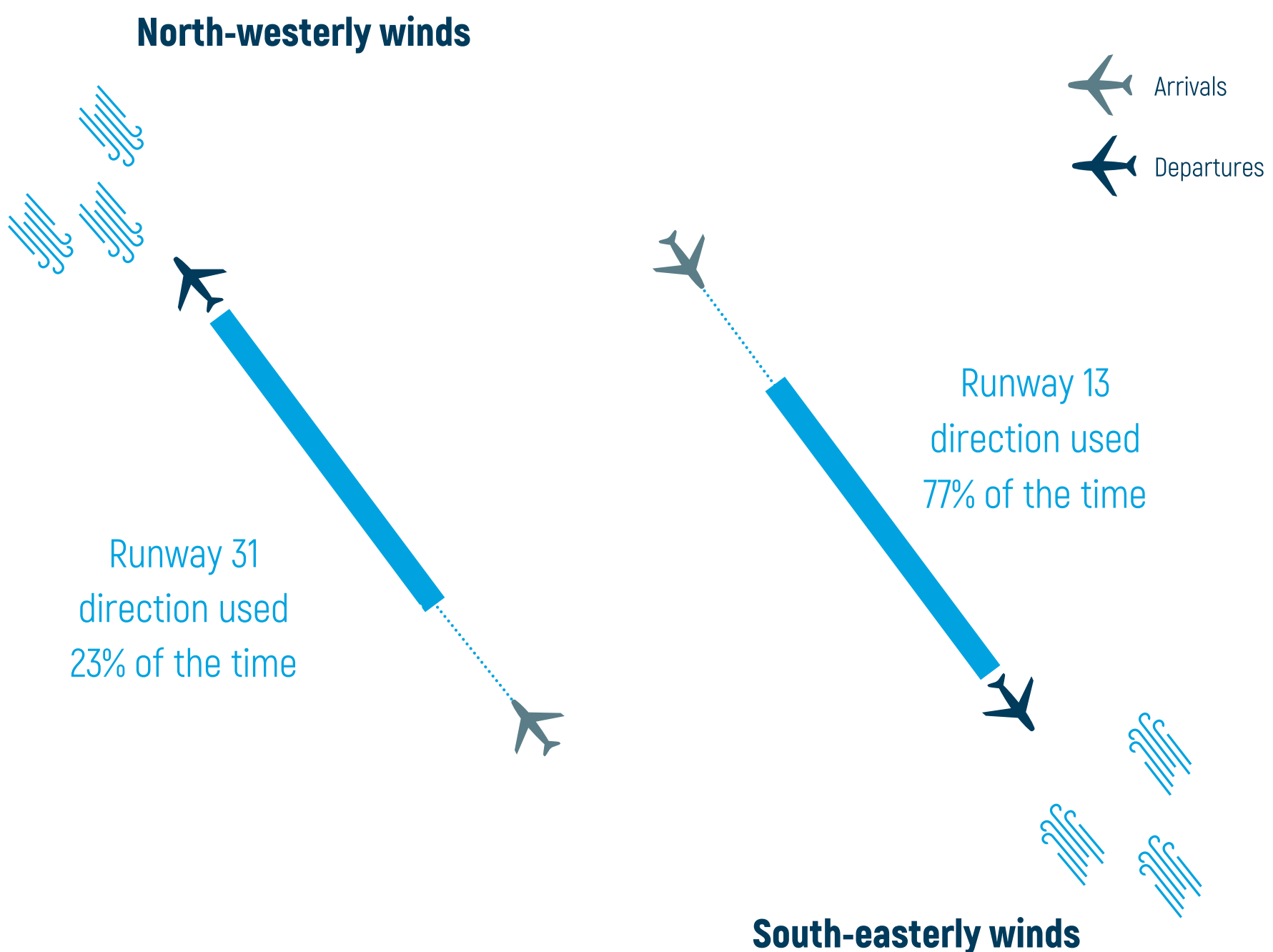
The new runway at Sunshine Coast Airport will be named Runway 13 and Runway 31.

HOW WILL THE NEW RUNWAY BE USED AT SUNSHINE COAST AIRPORT?

Aircraft usually take off and land into the wind.

For most of the year (77% of the time) Sunshine Coast has south-easterly winds (sea breezes) and the airport will operate from Runway 13.

When there are north-westerly winds Runway 31 will be used (23% of the time).



KEY POINTS

-  On a busy day 17 aircraft arrive and 17 aircraft depart Sunshine Coast Airport
-  The airport is busiest during the day (from 11am - 4pm)
-  The runway can be used in two different directions and is named for the direction it is being used - Runway 13 or Runway 31
-  Aircraft usually take off and land into wind
-  The wind at Sunshine Coast Airport is mainly 'sea breezes' from the south-east and determines which runway can be used
-  For most of the year Runway 13 is used (77% of the time)
-  Less of the time Runway 31 is used (23% of the time)
-  Aircraft will arrive and depart the airport on standard arrival and departure paths (SIDs and STARs) which change depending on the runway being used
