Correspondence about the proposal was sent to the local council on 24 April 2019.

Communication with Schools and Hospitals

Correspondence about the proposal was sent to one school and one preschool in the area on 24 April 2019.

The consultation was promoted via Airservices Twitter feed on 22 April 2019.

Information was provided to industry, including airlines and Merimbula Airport, on 23 April 2019.
